

CORRUPTION, ECONOMIC MISMANAGEMENT AND VIOLATIONS OF HUMAN RIGHTS: CNDD-FDD's LEADERSHIP AGAINST ITS OWN PARTY.



Corruption, economic mismanagement and violations of human rights are the basis of muzzling the people of Burundi. The tone was set within the CNDD-FDD in February 2007 and the epidemic has spread to all institutions. Today, nobody doubts that the hidden agenda of the congress scheduled at Ngozi and all the misfortunes that followed it. Today, a parliamentarian who leaves his party or which is excluded from the latter for one reason or another is automatically deleted from the National Assembly or Senate in violation of Article 156 of the Constitution.
